# Meeting Minutes

#### 6:30pm Guest Speakers: Josh Sunders, The Answer Class

- There is a college for everyone
- Kids are stressed about these tests, so why do it?
- The SAT, ACT tests are standardized and that is important
- Some schools want ACT, SAT or some want nothing (about a 1,000 that do not require scores)
- Fairtest.org -keeps track of all schools that do not require schools
- Merit Scholarships based on SAT scores
- Acceptance rate is based on a school's ranking
- ACT, SAT are almost the same- so pick one if they are stressed about two tests
- ACT = 175 minutes, 215 questions, out of 36, math/english/writing/science sections (score is an average of the 4 areas)
- SAT = 180 minutes, 154 questions, out of 1600, math 800 & read/write 800
- Everything is a scaled score on both tests, not a raw score
- Google: Concordance SAT/ACT and it will give you an equivalent score for both tests so you can compare them
- You can use calculator on both tests
- At the end of the test you can stay behind and write an essay as an extra "bump" for admissions
  - (extra 40-50 minutes after the test is over)
- You have to move quickly on both tests, time management is critical
- Check the Admissions page from each college to know exactly what is required
- Score Choice you can choose which of the test date scores you want to send the college (they cannot see the other scores)- do this if a college does not do Super Score
- Super Score (take the best of each section from the multiple times that you took the test)
- SAT (given in Oct, Nov, Dec, March, April, May, June, August)
- ACT (given in Sept, Oct, Dec, Feb, April, June, July)
- Take the test 2-3 times to increase your score but don't take it back to back, give yourself time to improve
- There so no reason to take the test if you have not prepared, you have to do something to prepare (hire a tutor, buy a book, take a class, take practice tests online or paper copy)
- Khan academy has lots of resources to study

- Register about 30 days before your child wants to take the test
- Prepare about 3x week for 30 minutes of practice three months before
