- 1. In the 4th bullet point, add the names of the high schools we are talking about so the bullet reads: "Redistricting, if necessary, should be done in such a way as to impact the fewest number of families necessar6y to achieve the desired outcome. For example, students at an overcrowded school, like Howard HS, should be assigned to an under utilized school, like Marriotts Ridge HS, without the domino affect of impacting schools in between, like Mt. Hebron HS.
- 2. The addition of a 5th bullet point to read: HCPSS should research flex time, and consortiums form surrounding counties like Baltimore, Anne Arundel and Montgomery County that are facing the same over crowding issues as Howard County.
